Inspect case for rot and make repairs as required. Supply and fit new solid brass, ball race pulley wheels. Rake out existing pointing, seal voids and renew sand mastic. Refit pockets. Fit new upper sash with nylon core sash rope. Fit new parting beads with integral brush strips. Fit new lower sash and re-rope. Fit new baton rods with integral brush strips. Fit moulding to eke with integral brush strip. Fit new lockable brighton sash fastener. Fit key operated height restrictors.
